Clinician Requirements

1. Should have at least 10 years of experience with NFHS rules.
2. Should be a 'Certified' official.
3. Should have expertise in knowledge of rules and their application
4. Should understand the rules and the intent of the rules
5. Should have held a chapter officer position. This does not necessarily mean being a board member. It can include trainer, chapter rules interpreter or other titles that are not necessarily on a chapter's board. It is required that the office be a real, functioning office that brings value to the chapter.
6. Excellent communication and presentation skills are required.
7. Should be supportive of the current clinicians and their vision
8. Should be able to speak to large groups and handle random questions on the fly.
9. Should be able to follow prepared presentations.
10. Should be available during state meeting and clinic time. (Approximately July 12-Aug 10)
