### **Playoff Eligibility**

If you haven't posted that minimum score, time is running out. **Friday, November 1 is the final day for the Member's Test and the Online Clinic.** The test and clinic will not be available after November 1, so please don't wait until the last minute. And members now have 25 attempts to post a winning score. The time to perform is NOW!

#### The Texas Way


